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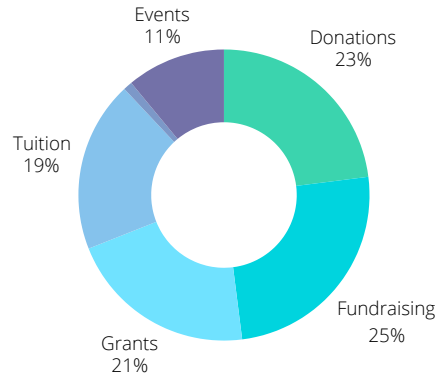

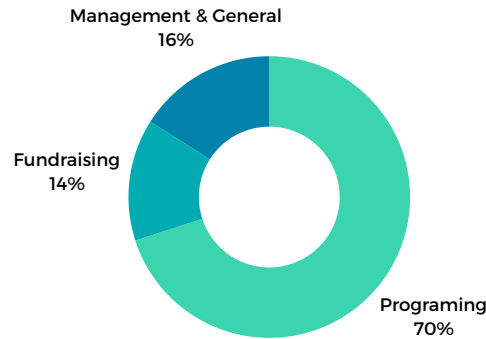

I am thrilled to share the highlights of our 2024 Annual Report, showcasing the impactful strides made by Leadership Unlimited, made possible by your support. Through diverse and impactful programs tailored to the unique needs of Hall County, we are building a stronger, more connected future.

Leadership Tomorrow remains our flagship initiative, and we are excited to celebrate the program’s 40th class in 2025! Over the years, it has grown and evolved, with Class 38 graduating in May 2024 after completing five distinctive community impact projects. We are proud to share that many of these graduates have already begun serving on local nonprofit boards, further demonstrating their commitment to leadership and service.

Our **Youth Leadership Tomorrow** program saw a record number of applicants this year, underscoring the enthusiasm of high school students seeking leadership opportunities. To meet this growing demand, we piloted a Youth Leadership Summit last summer. Building on its success, the current YLT class will plan and execute their own Summit on May 1, 2025—a dynamic opportunity for them to put their leadership skills into action.

Our **board of directors** completed strategic planning, crafting a vision for the next three years and confirming our focus on delivering high-quality leadership and community engagement training.

We also welcomed two new team members: **Samantha Moss**, Program Coordinator, who will enhance program delivery, and **Maria Vasquez**, Community Engagement Coordinator, leading Elevate Grand Island and fostering community connections.
